Resolutions:

- 791 Recommend amendments to the City's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code to include broad categories of land use designations within which several districts could be located rather than having a particular land use designation linked to each zoning district as it is today.
- 804 Review and recommend Regional Growth Center Subarea Plan Ad-Hoc Advisory Committee's Draft Subarea Plan.
- 817 Refers the existing City zoning and development regulations regarding State-licensed and regulated marijuana related uses to the Planning Commission, to seek public opinion, review and provide recommendations.
- 819 The City Council directs the Planning Commission to review and make recommendations regarding changing message signs in accordance with Council direction.
- 821 City Council hereby refers the City-initiated proposed rezone of the vacant residential parcels at the corner of 54th and Bridgeport Way, fronting Bridgeport Way and immediately adjacent to the U.P. Care Center to allow commercial use to the Planning Commission, to seek public opinion, review and provide recommendations regarding the proposed rezone.
